Dr. Huang is a Professor in Graduate School of Global Environmental Studies, Sophia University, Japan and also serves as the Director of the Institute for Studies of the Global Environment, which is a cross-disciplinary research organization within Sophia University. He received his Bachelor from Fudan University, China, Master and Ph.D. degrees from the University of Tokyo, Japan. His career includes Associate Professor in Graduate School of Frontier Sciences, the University of Tokyo; Associate Professor at Kanazawa University, Japan and Professor for Joint Educational Program between International Center for Water Hazard and Risk Management under the auspices of UNESCO and National Graduate Institute for Policy Studies, Japan. Passionate about water, his study evolved from fluid dynamics to water quality modeling and to integrated watershed science and management. In recent years, his main research focus is sustainability science from water perspective such as wetland conservation and wise use, integration of flood risk analysis with urban planning and innovative water resources development as well. He has published more than 80 peer-reviewed papers in various journals and also served as reviewer and editor for various international journals.
